RELEASE FROM LIABILITY

This Release ("Release") is made by the Parent or Guardian ("the Parent") of the Student named above ("the Student"). This release is made in connection with the enrollment of the Student at Besant Hill School ("the School"). It is the purpose of this Release to limit the liability of the School in connection with all activities in which the Student may engage ("the activities"), whether voluntary or required.

The activities include, but are not limited to: camping, athletics, fitness, cultural events, and miscellaneous outings, which may change from year to year. Some of these activities have direct supervision, while others are unsupervised. The Student has my permission to participate in the activities. Some of these activities are listed in the Besant Hill School Handbook and on the Besant Hill School website, however information about specific activities is available from the School; inquiry by parents is encouraged.

Supervision by the School will vary, depending on the nature of the activity. The activities frequently involve some degree of risk of physical harm to the Student. The Parent understands that such risks exist.

This Release is entered as part of the consideration of the enrollment of the Student at the School, and as consideration for permitting the Student to be involved in such activities. It shall be the sole judgment of the School as to the degree of supervision required for any activity. Parent agrees that it will make no claim against the School for injury or damage resulting from the participation of the Student in the activities. Parent voluntarily releases, discharges, waives, and relinquishes all claims or actions that Parent may have against Besant Hill School, its officers, agents, employees and volunteers for bodily injury, emotional distress, property damage and/or wrongful death occurring to the Student, arising out of any negligence on the part of Besant Hill School, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers. It is the intention of this agreement to exempt and relieve Besant Hill School, its officers, agents, employees and volunteers, from liability for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death caused by negligence.

The appropriate court in Ventura County, California, shall have exclusive jurisdiction with respect to any controversy or dispute arising out of or relating to the Release. If any litigation is commenced between the Parent and the School concerning this Release, the party prevailing in such litigation shall be entitled, in addition to such other relief as may be granted, to a reasonable sum for attorney's fees and costs, which shall be determined by the court.

DAY STUDENT CAR AGREEMENT
(Day students only)

Dear Day Parents and Students:

The Besant Hill School policy regarding automobiles is in place for the safety and protection of our students. For this reason, boarding students are not allowed to have cars for personal use; either on campus, or parked at local residences.

Because of this policy, it can put an undue pressure on our **DAY STUDENT DRIVERS**. As a School we want to protect the privilege of day student driving and, in return, we ask that Day Students abide by the following rules in order to maintain their car privilege:

- Day students must drive safely and responsibly to and from school, as well as on campus.
- All day students are required to arrive on time to school. Day students are welcome and encouraged to join us for breakfast to avoid a class tardy.
- Day students are NOT permitted to leave campus until they have completed their last commitment for the day. In other words, day students are not allowed to come and go throughout the day.
- Day students are required to park their vehicles in the designated parking lot below the Main Offices.
- Day students are not permitted to drive boarding students, UNLESS they have obtained permission for an approved excursion or departure. The parents of both day and boarding student must call in their permission and the students must receive verbal approval from the Director of Residential Life/Dean of Students.
- Senior day students in good standing may obtain permission to drive senior boarding students in good standing, for an excursion, through the Dean of Student's Office and with the approval of their parents or guardian.

We have read and understand the above Day Student Driving Agreement and agree to comply with the rules and guidelines outlined above.
