is a specialized program designed to meet the needs of all students at their current academic achievement level.

Students with mild learning differences and/or academic challenges in organization and time management are given the support they need to achieve success in our rigorous college preparatory program.

INDIVIDUALIZED SUPPORT

Our **Instructional Support Center** is designed to offer students individualized instruction in learning strategies. Organization and time management skills are the foundation of this program. Additionally, students receive both individual and small group support for the academic work of their core curriculum classes.

STAFF-SUPPORTED STUDY AREA

ISP study hall is open Sunday-Thursday evenings. Students attend ISP study hall to study in an **ISP staffed and structured study environment**.

ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY
